

What to Bring to Spring Retreat 2025

A wonderfully pleasant and flexible attitude

A hunger for God and a desire to know Him more

An appetite for some awesome food

Your Bible and a pen or pencil to take notes with

Sleeping Bag or twin-sized bedding, and pillow

Towels for your showers (yes, you must shower)

Clothes for play
